

Aslan's Place eBook Guidelines

Thank you for purchasing an eBook from Aslan's Place! There are so many ways to read eBooks that it would be very difficult to provide full directions for all types of devices. The purpose of this document is to give you some basic guidelines for the most common eBook reading methods.

First, a note about the file name for the eBooks. You may notice that the filename for many eBooks are just a bunch of numbers. For instance, the file name for "Come Up Higher" is "9780983454663." This is because eBooks are usually listed with the ISBN number as the filename.

eBooks from Aslan's Place come in two different formats.

- [.epub – This file format is intended for use with the Barnes and Noble Nook, Apple devices like the iPad and iPhone, Sony e-Readers and even Windows and Apple Computers](#)
- [.prc – This file format is intended for use with the Amazon Kindle.](#)

Using .epub files

As mentioned earlier, the .epub format is very versatile. We have provided basic guidelines on the following types of readers:

Using .epub files with Windows and Apple desktop and laptop computers.

There are many free eReader programs available for Windows and Apple computers. However, we have found that the eReader "Calibre" is popular and easy to use. You may find the download for Calibre here:

You'll just need to click on the icon for your type of computer, download and install the program.

Note: Calibre also gives you're the ability to coordinate your eBooks with a portable eReader. If you don't have an eReader device, you would just select "generic" when prompted to choose a device during installation of Calibre.

Once you have installed Calibre, you would download the .epub version of the eBook you purchased, and then just drag and drop it onto the Calibre desktop.

Using .EPUB files with the Barnes and Noble Nook

1. Attach the Nook to your computer using the included USB cable. The device will appear as a removable disk under **My Computer/Computer** for Windows users or the **Finder** for Mac users.
2. Copy the .epub file from your download folder onto the folder on your nook called "My Documents"
3. You may need to choose the option called "Check for new content" from your Nook Menu.
4. You should now see your new book on your Nook menu under the My Documents section.

Using .epub files with the iPad, iPhones, and iPod Touch

There are two common options for eReader apps on these devices:

- Stanza from Lexcycle – this is a free eReader app that is very popular. It is available [here](#). This website also provides guidelines on how to use the app.
- iBooks Application – this is available as a free download from the Apple Store.

Transferring your files to your reading device using the iBooks app:

iPod Touch: Download the e-book using your computer. Then, in iTunes, choose File > Add to Library. Connect iPod touch to your computer, select the book in the Books pane in iTunes, then sync iPod touch.

iPad: Download the e-book using your computer, then add it to your iTunes library. Connect iPad to your computer, select the book in the Books pane in iTunes, then sync iPad.

iPhone: Use iTunes to sync your books between iPhone and your computer. When iPhone is connected to your computer, the Books pane lets you select which items to sync. Sync an ePub book to iPhone: Download the book using your computer. Then, in iTunes, choose File > Add to Library. Connect iPhone to your computer, select the book in the Books pane in iTunes, then sync iPhone.

Using .prc files

.prc files can be uploaded to Kindle (and other dedicated e-reading devices such as Cybook and iLiad). Instructions for transferring .prc e-book to your Kindle are as follows.

Transferring .prc E-Books to Kindle

You have two options:

- Wireless transfer
- Transfer using your Kindle USB cable

Wireless Kindle transfer

You can transfer your .prc e-book wirelessly into your Kindle by using your dedicated Kindle email address. (This address can be found on the Manage Your Kindle page at Amazon.) Download the eBook .prc file to your computer. Email the file to your dedicated Kindle email address and Kindle will wirelessly deliver the file directly into your Kindle.

Using Your Kindle USB Cable

To transfer your .prc eBook using your Kindle USB cable, connect the cable to your Kindle. If you are using a PC, your Kindle content folders will appear as a removable drive in Windows Explorer. If you are using a Mac, your Kindle content folders will appear in Mac OS Finder. (If you have an optional SD memory card installed, it will also appear as a drive independent of the Kindle.) You need only to copy the .prc file to the documents folder on your Kindle.

Please note: If you download the Kindle App on any of your reading devices, you will only be able to read books that you purchased through the Amazon Kindle Book Store. You will not be able to read eBooks purchased from Aslan's Place. Therefore, you are better off using the .epub file for other types of reading devices.
